

The Upside of AP Automation



Manual processing of AP, with its paper and mailing costs and labor-intensive workflows, is time consuming and expensive. And without clear audit trails, it leaves organizations at risk for non-compliance with government regulations.

AP automation uses multifunctional peripherals to bridge paper and physical environments with scanning, optical character recognition, routing, tracking, archiving, and electronic invoicing.

The Pitfalls of Traditional AP Process

2.8 days
to Manually Validate and Process an invoice¹

The average cost of processing an invoice with a low level of automation can be up to **20 times higher** than the cost of processing with a high level of automation along with inability to capture early payment discounts.²

On average, **3.6% of invoices have errors**³

The more times an invoice is handled, the greater the chances of it being lost or misfiled.

Cost of finding a lost invoice: \$125⁴

Cost to replace a lost invoice: \$225⁴

Other issues associated with manual AP processing:



Inquiries & Remediation

Higher number of vendor inquiries on status and more time spent remediating disputes. Without automated filing and archiving, this is even more of a challenge.



Duplicate Payments

Higher incidence of duplicate payments, particularly in organizations with fewer than 250 employees.



Fraud

Usually the result of inadequate process controls.

Reduced delays and errors so payments are made on time.



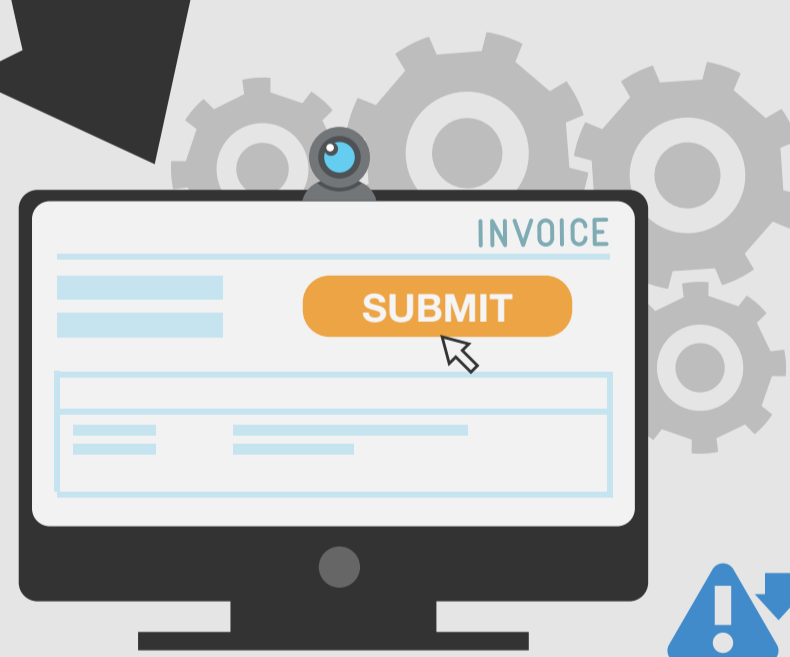
Improved Access to Information

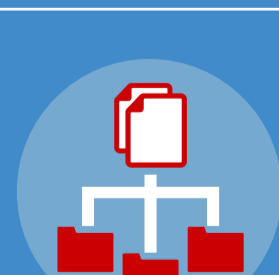

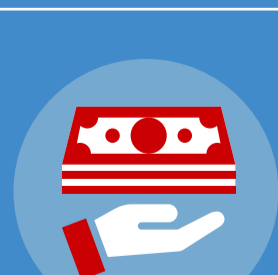
